Run of show notes

Mr. Jones will require a full stage wash as he approaches the stage.

Please have his lavalier microphone on and his presentation up on the screen(s) before he reaches the podium/ lectern.

At the end of the presentation, Mr. Jones will raise his hands and say, "Thank you very much." Mr. Jones leaves the stage.

If the budget is available, supplemental lighting should be provided for both the stage area and the podium.

Hospitality

- Mr. Jones requires a bottle of water at the podium

Technical Requirements

Mr. Jones will have his own Apple laptop (Macbook Pro) and presentation remote. His presentation is in Keynote format; he will not be able to use your PC/ laptop due to embedded video content in his presentation.

- A confidence monitor of at least 22 inches must be provided
- Please note, Mr. Jones is blind in his right eye.

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- Mr. Jones' laptop prefers his laptop be placed at back stage tech table or tech center in the back of the room.
- If presentation is to take place in a small room, be sure the cable from his laptop to the projector ensures the largest image possible on the screen.
- Mr. Jones requests that the stage be raised above the general level of seating to assure the best possible visibility. Further, additional staging should be provided as Mr. Jones generally roams the stage during his presentation

Sound

- Wireless lavalier microphone with new batteries installed (Shure WL185 or equivalent)
- 1/8" headphone connection for laptop at podium/ lectern (RapcoHorizon LTIBLOX, or equivalent)

Lighting

- House lighting dim, enough to safely navigate the room.
- General stage wash with podium special keyed lighting (if budget allows)

Video

- Appropriate sized data projector(s) for the venue; 1024X768 native resolution

Example: 6,000 lumen projector for 10X14 video screen

- Apple mini DisplayPort to VGA adapter
- Active VGA distribution amplifier. DO NOT USE A "WYE" SPLITTER
- Minimum 22" Confidence monitor down stage center
- If two or more laptops are to be used for the presentation/ event, an appropriate VGA switcher/ scalar must be used
- Important! The screen should be placed high enough above the floor of the room so that the audience can view the entire screen. At several points in the presentation there is information on the bottom edge of the screen that is very important to the presentation.
- If the audience is larger than 900, client should consider using two screens. Please contact Mr. Jones' office to consult on the audio visual requirements for audiences larger than 900 people.
